

SERMON SNIPPET:

Series: A H.O.P.E. FILLED FUTURE – PART 3 Message: Hope Filled Giving Scripture: Jeremiah 29:11-14 & 2 Corinthians NRSV Preacher: Rev. Dr. Anthony Hood

Today, we conclude our series of sermons connected to our 2025 Stewardship Campaign: A H.O.P.E. Filled Future: Helping Our People Engage. The focus of this stewardship campaign is helping each of you engage in biblical based stewardship

of your time, talents, and treasure. Today, we will examine stewarding our treasure as we focus our thoughts on the following theme: Hope Filled Giving.

Holding on to hope is challenging, because there are always obstacles, hardships, dilemmas, frustrations, heartbreak, trauma, and drama. Hope filled living is about holding on to hope, especially when our current situation and circumstances do not look hopeful. Hope filled living fuels hope filled serving, for if I am convinced God has a plan, then I can serve with joy even while I am enduring hardships. Hope filled living is the foundation for hope filled serving, which fuels our hope filled giving.

Hope filled giving is an act of worship that declares we trust and rely upon the God that has a plan for our hope filled future. Our worship is an act of love and demonstration of devotion for God. As our giving is an act of love, it must flow from a heart that is joyful and willing. Which brings us to our text from 2 Corinthians. In 2 Corinthians, we find the apostle Paul offering words of instruction to the church at Corinth about hope filled giving versus begrudging or conditional giving. Paul begins with practical instruction, that each of us should give, as we have decided in our heart/minds to give. The decision to give should not be made reluctantly, nor from being compelled to do so. Giving must flow from a heat this is joyful, willful, hope filled, and loving.

Paul further elaborates that our giving recognizes that God is the source of all we have, and God will ensure we have all we need, so that we can be a blessing to others. Hope filled giving attunes our hearts and minds to God's purpose and plan, partnering with God to transform our church and community. In short, hope filled giving invest in the those who are here, those who are yet to come, and those who may never join but who need to know God loves them.

Stewarding a life of hope-filled giving is a call to align our hearts and lives with god's purpose and plan. Hope filled giving is an act of legacy building for those who are yet to come, but who will need a place to connect with God. Those who founded this church gave believing that God would bless and prosper the movement of methodist amongst the farmlands of their day. Now, the mantle and legacy of those who have paved the way for us is squarely upon us, that we might engage in hope filled giving to provide spiritual home for transformation


