Sermon: TRUE HAPPINESS Scripture: Psalm 119:1-3 NRSV

What makes you happy? I will give you a moment to think about the things that make you happy. For some, it is the thrill of accomplishing a goal/task you did not think you could. For others, it is the times that they spend with the people they love. The world attempts to convince us that happiness is a commodity that can be bought from our local mall, real estate agent or

car salesperson.

The German inventor, Fredrick Koenig offers us a different perspective. He writes: "We tend to forget that happiness doesn't come as a result of getting something we don't have, but rather of recognizing and appreciating what we do have.¹" As followers of Christ, we have found, True Happiness comes from God.

In our text, we find the author reflecting upon the beauty and majesty of the Torah as God's instruction for right living. These verses offer us a profound statement of faith, that Happiness, Joy, and Blessedness are found in relationship with God. For the author, keeping God's statutes, instructions, and decrees are not laborious, nor an unrealistic legal obligation.

For the author, it is a sign of love and devotion to a God that is good, merciful, and just. As followers of Christ, we understand that God wants relationship with us and was willing to pay the ultimate price to establish that relationship. A relationship that offers us peace that settles our anxious hearts, a relationship that encourages us, a relationship that offers us True Happiness.

Siblings in Christ, true happiness is cultivated in the hearts and souls of those who have been touched by the love of God.




