
Sermon: HOW FAR WOULD WE GO? Scripture: Matthew 2:1-12 NRSV Rev. Dr. Anthony Hood

The wise ones have traveled for a year and now they have arrived in Jerusalem. They stop at the palace, adhering to royal protocol, thinking that the one who was foretold would be there. They enter the courts, paying homage to Herod, seeking to offer blessings, but learn there has not been a royal birth. After the chief priests and Sadducees review the historical records, it is discovered that the promised one was to be born in

Bethlehem. The wise ones have come a long way; now they must continue to Bethlehem. What do we do when we face initial disappointment and setbacks? Unexpected detours along the pathways of our lives can often halt our progress or deter us from pursuing God's purpose. Yet, what the wise men demonstrate for us is resilience and determination. They had come all this way; they were going to see Jesus.

How far would we go? How many obstacles and frustration would we endure just to see, worship, and live for Jesus? Would we remain steadfast amidst our detractors' constant belittling and ridicule? Would we overcome our internal voice attempting to persuade us to have a little more "fun" before we serious about seeking Jesus? Would we yield our desire to prioritize our personal preferences in order to challenge ourselves to love more, serve more, give more, and share more of God's love with others? How far would we go to be in the presence of Christ, to meet the needs of hurting people and live purposeful and reverent lives for Christ? How far would we go and are you willing to start today?
